This competition is being run under BRC rules, it is the responsibility of every competitor to familiarise themselves with the BRC rule book 2017. The Rule book is available to download from either the Area web pages or The BRC web site.

LORRY & VEHICLE PARKING: All competitors & others must adhere to instructions from the Parking Stewards when given.

Horses & ponies must not be placed in trailers when they are detached from the towing vehicle, nor left unattended for long periods tied outside Lorries or trailers.

MUST NOT muck out vehicles on showground premises, nor allow their Horses or Ponies to walk or graze on grass verges at any time.,

Organiser's and its officials and agents cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, loss or damage, however caused arising out of or at the competition.

shall be solely responsible for the consequences of loss, or

damage done to, or occasioned by, or arising from, any animal and indemnify the organisers, club,

officials, agents, invitees and the Showground owners against all damages, actions,

claims, proceedings, costs and or expenses in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show.

(Children under 16 must be under adult supervision at all times).

tagged with a **BRC ORANGE tag**, available on the day at the Secretary's tent.

Any Objection must be lodged with the secretary within 5 minutes of the end of the class

concerned, together with a deposit of £20.00 Returnable if the objection is sustained.

The organiser's reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation except to the appropriate body.

The organisers cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule and reserve the right to cancel classes or amend classes or times in any way.

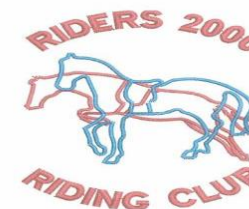
Health and Safety and Welfare:
