

RULES

Withdrawals/ Alterations /Refunds. There will be NO REFUNDS WHATSOEVER for withdrawals from qualifier classes after making payment of a prelim entry. There will be NO REFUNDS WHATSOEVER of unaffiliated Entries.

No Substitution of horse and or rider will be permitted under any circumstances after 12 noon on Thursday 24TH May (unless a medical or vet certificate is provided). Substitutions when allowed will be permitted within teams only, any such substitutions permitted, will have to take whatever times the original combination was given no allowance will be made for any other rides.

Individuals may NOT be substituted.

In the event of cancellation of the event for any reason £15 will be retained for admin purposes for each horse entered

Team/Individual Entries (Qualifying Classes)

IT IS A CONDITION OF ENTRY THAT 2 HELPERS PER TEAM ARE PROVIDED TO ASSIST WITH THE RUNNING OF THE EVENT (1 per 2 individuals or ½ day for 1 individual)

A DELEGATED HELP TEAM LEADER for each club to be appointed, named & details SENT BY EMAIL TO ENTRIES SEC AT CLOSE OF PRELIM ENTRY DATE & also included on the entry form attached to this schedule and a contact number provided for him/her. This person will be responsible for ensuring the correct number of helpers arrive at the event in time for briefing, and MUST BE PRESENT AT THE EVENT. Team entry will not be accepted without this information. AS Without helpers we cannot run the event!! ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT FULL ENTRY FEE

Conditions of Entry

- 1. BRITISH RIDING CLUB RULES SHALL APPLY. REFER TO BRC. RULES/HAND BOOK 2018 FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY.**
- 2. Area 15. Qualifiers require Prelim entries to BRC. 21 CLEAR days before the event date.**
- 3. No horse will be allowed to enter more than one class.**
- 4. Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times. Young children must be supervised at all times**
- 5. Horses must not be left unattended, while tied up outside vehicles in the lorry park. Please do not muck out horse boxes or trailers in the lorry park and please take your litter home.**
- 6. Any objections and protests must be handed to the secretary in writing with a deposit of £20, within 10 minutes of the results being published. The deposit will be retained if the objection is not upheld.**
- 7. BRC Rider membership cards & Passport/Vaccination certificates WILL BE INSPECTED. HORSES MUST BE PRESENTED IN BRIDLES with their Passport/Vaccination Certificate before the start of competition, for all horses competing in Area 15 Qualifiers. Horses without the correct and valid certificate will be eliminated immediately and will not be allowed to compete.**
- 8 ALL JUNIORS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESPONSIBLE ADULT**

THE ORGANISERS RESEVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO ANY CLASS WITHOUT EXPLANATION, EXEPT TO THE APPROPRIATE BODY

Class 7. BRC. Junior HT100: Test: BRC. HT 100Q (2013)
For teams & individuals (Three Day Event at Championships)

Class 8. BRC. Senior HT80: Test: BRC. HT 80Q (2013)
for teams & individuals (One Day Event at Championships)

Class 9. BRC. Senior HT90: Test: BRC. HT 90Q (2013)
for teams & individuals. (Two Day Event at Championships)

Class 10. BRC Senior HT100: Test: BRC. HT 100Q (2013)
for teams & individuals. (Three Day Event at Championships)

Class 11. BRC Junior & Senior 100+: Test: BRC. HT 100+Q (2013)
for mixed or separate teams & individuals. For this class Juniors must be 12 years old or over on 1st January in the current year. (Three Day Event at Championships) Age as 1st January 2018. Juniors under 18 years & seniors 18 years & over
