Safeguarding Crib Sheet

Physical Contact Guidance

Physical contact should be in response to the needs of the child and a good general guideline to keep in mind is: **Don't do something that the child can do for themselves.**

Physical contact during sport should always be intended to meet the child's needs, **NOT** the adult's.

You should only use physical contact if your aim is to:

- · Assist a child to mount or dismount
- Coach a child to develop a sports skills or technique
- Prevent an injury or accident from occurring
- Treat an injury

You must:

- Explain to the child the nature and reason for any physical contactreinforcing the teaching or coaching
- Unless the situation is an emergency, you should ask the child for permission
- Encourage the children to voice their concerns if any physical contact makes them feel uncomfortable or threatened

Use of Photography Guidance

Organisers should ensure:

- Children and parents should be made aware that a photographer will be present
- Consent should be given from both parties on the event parental consent form Photographers must:
- Be given a clear brief
- Wear identification
- Not be given unsupervised access to competitors
